

INFORMATION NOTICE

Removal of a Vehicle from an Approved Restricted Area Moreton Bay Island (Cleveland Customer Service Centre)

- 1. Notification of intention to remove a vehicle from a restricted area is to be made **in writing** by the registered operator.
- Requests must be received by Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) Cleveland Customer Service Centre (CSC) at least one (1) business day prior to the vehicle being removed from the restricted area.
- 3. Written requests can be lodged **in person** at the Cleveland CSC, Cnr Bloomfield Street and Ross Court, by fax to **3821 2232** or by email to <u>islandpermits@tmr.qld.gov.au</u>.

Note: Faxed requests must state a return fax number.

- 4. All requests must state the following details:
 - a. Name, address and signature of registration operator,
 - b. Vehicle registration number,
 - c. Make and model of vehicle,
 - d. Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or chassis number, and
 - e. All dates the request is for.
- 5. Any vehicle removed from a restricted area for more than seven (7) days will require a pro-rata payment of the registration fee to be paid. This fee must be made at a TMR CSC or Queensland Government Agency Program (QGAP) **prior to** the issue of the *Letter of Authority*.

Note: The minimum pro-rata fee charged is \$20.00.

6. More than one (1) Letter of Authority to remove a vehicle from a restricted area issued back-to-back that exceeds seven (7) days in entirety, will require a pro-rata payment of the registration fee to be paid. This fee must be made at a TMR CSC or QGAP **prior to** the issue of the *Letter of Authority*.

Note: The minimum pro-rata fee charged is \$20.00.

- 7. If the vehicle registration expires during the time that the *Letter of Authority* to remove a vehicle from a restricted area is granted, the *Letter of Authority* will only be valid up until the expiry date of registration.
- 8. The *Letter of Authority* to remove a vehicle from a restricted area must remain in the vehicle at all times.
- 9. The *Letter of Authority* to remove a vehicle from a restricted area must not be altered by any persons other than an authorised TMR representative.
- 10. Suspected abuse of the concession, such as continued requests for a *Letter of Authority* to remove a vehicle from a restricted area, may result in the concession being withdrawn. Restricted area concessions are granted based on that the vehicle will be solely used in a restricted area/zone.
